Shift Key

Press the **Shift** key with any other key

- ▶ Type a character given at the top of the key



Shift Key

- ▶ Eg- The key with the numeral **1** has the exclamation mark (!) on top



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Shift Key

- ▶ Eg- The key with the numeral **1** has the exclamation mark (!) on top
- ▶ To type **!** press the **Shift** key together with **1**


